

Security Camera Trailer Set-up Instructions

1. Setting up the trailer:

- a. After receiving your camera trailer from Street Smart, the first thing is to do is place the trailer in an optimal position that will fulfill the following requirements
 - i. **Solar panels are facing due south are unobstructed from sunlight**
 1. Don't place too close to buildings, structures, trees, etc, that will decrease sunlight hours on the solar panels of the trailer
 2. Orient the trailer so that the mast of the trailer doesn't obscure the panels
 3. Orient panels to face due south **before** cranking up the mast
 - ii. **Optimal distance between the camera trailer and whatever you're hoping to observe is 20-150ft**
 1. Try to place your camera trailer so that what you're hoping to observe isn't too close or too far away from the trailer
 - iii. **Orient that trailer so that the mast doesn't block the camera's view to anything important**
- b. Once you have found a good location for the trailer that satisfies the 3 requirements above, extend and lower down the jacks that are on each corner of the trailer.
 - i. Raise the jacks until
 1. the wheels are off the ground
 2. the trailer platform is level
- c. Now, proceed to step 2 to attach the camera to the trailer and raise the most.

2. Attach the camera to the mast: *Please handle camera with care!*

- a. Tools required
 - i. T30 torx driver
 - ii. Ladder

4. Secure the Trailer (*Remember, you are responsible for the trailer and camera while it's on rent. Customer to provide their own locks*)

- a. Insert lock on **winch** to prevent the mast from being lowered.



- b. Insert lock on **battery box** to prevent contents from being stolen/vandalized.



- c. Lock / Remove **trailer wheels** to prevent theft.

- d. Lock / Remove **trailer tongue/hitch** to prevent theft.

- a. Street Smart will not be held liable for any losses or damages associated with the use of our camera(s).
- b. Camera records 24/7 and stores video for 7-30 days (depending on configuration). Additional storage available upon request at additional charge.
- c. Connection to camera is slower when viewed through a mobile device
- d. Standard rental includes 10gb data/per month. This equates to approximately 40-50 minutes of streaming “real time” video per day.
